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## NOTES TO USERS AND SUGGESTED CITATION

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This report details the population characteristics of Chilton County, a place located in central Alabama. Knowledge of a place's population makeup is important to both those who live and work there as well as potential investors, workers, and residents. With population data, business owners can identify both purchasing and labor markets, government officials can accurately plan for their citizens' needs, and residents can better know their community. Population data are very useful in promoting a place to businesses searching for production, distribution, and sales sites. Population data also can be used to promote a place to potential new residents. New businesses and residents are of concern to government officials tasked with forecasting tax revenues and planning public infrastructure and services provisions.

This report informs interested parties about the characteristics of Chilton County's population in five important topic areas. First, it describes the number of persons in Chilton County, the surrounding area, and major settlements. Second, this report describes the age structure and ethnic makeup of the population. Third, it gives detailed information on the county's income and educational attainment. Fourth, this report describes housing affordability, household composition, and migration. Last, the report addresses economic activities including employment, commuting, and economic sectors.
